



Project Graduation 2010 Habitat for Humanity Project

The goal is to give our students an opportunity to leave a true legacy from their graduating class. Project Graduation 2010 and Habitat for Humanity have a collaborative idea. The students will raise money for Projection Graduation 2010 and raise money to build a house in Parker County that will allow someone to fulfill their dream of home ownership. The students will also commit to helping build the house.

Here is what it can look like from a fund raising standpoint. We will have approximately 400 graduation seniors. Of those students, 200 will actively participate in the project.

The goal is to raise \$100,000.

Option 1:

200 students raise \$500 each

Option 2:

100 students raise \$750 each

100 students raise \$250 each

Option 3:

50 raise \$1,000 each

50 raise \$500 each

100 raise \$250 each

When each student solicits an individual or a company for donations, the students will inform them, the dollars will be used in two ways. Half the money raised will be used towards the graduation activities and half will be used to fund the building of the house. Here is the caveat to the Habitat piece. Each student will commit to working on the construction of the house at a minimum of 10 hours. So, if you raise \$500, \$250 will go towards graduation and \$250 will go towards the house, but broken down hourly. The student will solicit the Habitat dollars as 10 hours at \$25 per hour.
