OF

2012 PROJECT CELEBRATION MEETING

February 28, 2011

Meeting called to order by Melanie Lottin on February 28, 2011, at 6:00 p.m.

1. Treasurer's Report:

- Eighty-four people have made the \$100.00 contributed which PC 2012 has requested from each student.

2. Old Business:

- We have the following products remaining: 50 drawstring bags, 12 umbrellas, and approximately 400 bracelets.

- Paula Cox and Carol Rowe sold umbrellas and other products at Bear Cat baseball games.

- The first CHILI'S FUND-RAISER was held on February 9, 2011. We need to promote future CHILI'S FUND-RAISERS, to take place all day on March 9, 2011, April 13, 2011, and May 11, 2011. Melanie requested a notice be put in the COMMUNITY NEWS.

- The red carpet has been purchased by PC 2011, which will be used during the Promenade.

- Cookie Friday. Paula Cox and Cynthia Lambert have set up five teams with six members on each team. PC 2012 will take over cookie sales on May 13 or May 20, 2011. Paula and Cynthia conducted training last week and sold cookies at the ninth-grade center; the cookies were sold out in ten minutes. If the ninth-grade center begins providing two lunches next year, we may have more cookie sales. Earnings are approximately \$800.00 per month. The shift runs from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. More cookies are sold in the fall than in the spring. Teams usually make four to five boxes each Friday.

- Phone Bank. We have sent letters to parents, but need to elicit more parent participation. Rhonda prepared eight contact lists, each list containing twenty to thirty names and contact information. Volunteers taking contact lists will use a script. The script will include the following information: (1) notice of the April 11 and May 16, 2011 meetings; (2) a request for a \$100.00 contribution (contributor to receive an extra raffle ticket if the contribution is made before the end of the year); (3) confirmation of contact information; (4) product sales; and (5) the CHILI'S FUND-RAISER. Rhonda will send a script to those parents who have taken a phone list. Completed phone lists may be emailed to Rhonda or brought to the April meeting.

3. New Business:

- Promenade. Janice Mulliniks is chairing the committee and will need volunteers to decorate the gym/cafeateria on May 20, 2011. Those interested in decorating for Promenade may email Lynn or Melanie or sign up at the PC 2012 meeting in April.
- The Clay Shoot, which is being sponsored by ALEDO BUSINESS LEADERS, will take place on Saturday, March 5, 2011. PC 2012 will not receive a direct contribution from the group at this time. If anyone is available to help, please contact Steve Bartley or Craig Harbuck.
- At the next meeting, we will determine how many responses/contributions we received from the Phone Bank and the CHIL'S FUND-RAISER and determine what other things PC 2012 needs to do to increase parent contributions and fund-raising. We will also ask for volunteers for the Promenade. During the May meeting, we will ask for volunteers to chair and participate on the various committees needed for senior year (Football Parking, 50/50, Main Event, etc.). We will also send either a postcard or letter to the parents of the 2012 students.
