

**MINUTES
OF
2012 PROJECT CELEBRATION MEETING
November 7, 2011**

Meeting called to order by Melanie Loftin at 6:00 p.m.

1. Treasurer's Report:

- Treasurer reported our balance is \$23,689.18
- 175 postcard reminders were sent out; 6 responses were received.
- 139 students have paid the \$100 contribution.
